TIPS FOR THE SELECTION OF WATER SAVING PLANTS

BEFORE PLANTING:

- Identify soil, exposure and temperature extremes at your planting sites.
- Plan the area for its desired water use category and group plants of similar needs together.
- Discuss your selection with knowledgeable garden centre staff.
- Use a slow-release fertilizer according to your soil type. Do not *over*-fertilize or use high nitrogen fertilizers.

DURING PLANTING:

- Dig holes twice as wide and deep as the plant's rootball. Check that the subsoil drains well when the hole is filled with water.
- Use soil taken from the plant hole for backfill, adding a mix of organic material such as compost, and/or peatmoss.
- Place the top of the root ball level with the ground surface. Tamp backfill well to minimize further settlement, but do not *compact* the soil.
- Keep the plant well watered until it is established (1-2 years for perennials, trees and shrubs and 1-2 months for annuals), then **reduce watering** to the minimum required by your plant.

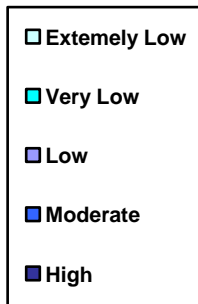
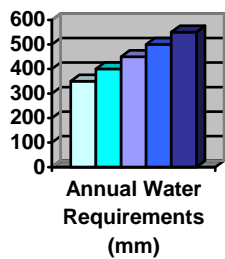
