# West Fraser Aquatic Centre

## Information For School District Public Swim Sessions

The intent of this letter is to ensure complete transparency and understanding of the policies and procedures for use of the West Fraser Aquatic Centre.

### Procedure:

All Teachers will book a minimum of seven (7) days in advance for the swims requested. Swim times must be confirmed to ensure adequate staff coverage. When booking, the Teacher in charge will provide the Booking Clerk with the list of any volunteers that will be in attendance, the number of participants that will be swimming and the average ages will also be a requirement. Upon arrival to the Cariboo Memorial Recreation Complex, the Teacher will check in with the Administration desk before admittance. **Students will then go get changed and then line up on deck to await lifeguard instructions.**

### West Fraser Aquatic Centre Guidelines:

- Maximum 30 Swimmers per booking.
- Supervision in the changerooms must be provided by the Teacher or volunteers.
- Infants and Toddlers must wear swim diapers when using the pool.
- Small children, especially infants, should be kept away from the swirl pool and other hot spots in the natatorium. Their small bodies overheat very quickly.
- All children 6 and younger must be always within arm's reach of an individual 16 years of age or older while in the pool. This ensures adequate supervision while participating in aquatic activities.
  - This is where volunteers in the water with the students would be beneficial; volunteers are not required to pay admittance fees.
  - There is a maximum of three children (under 7 years) per supervising guardian.
- Patrons with open wounds or sores are not permitted in the Aquatic Centre.
- Aquatic Centre patrons must listen to the instructions of the Aquatic Staff.
- Food, drink, and chewing gum are not permitted in the Aquatic Centre at any time.

Teachers/ Adult volunteers are responsible for all participants and their belongings while attending the Cariboo Memorial Recreation Complex.

### Rates:

- The Joint Use Agreement states any additional staff required due to a larger attendance request will be paid on a per lifeguard basis.
  - \$31.84 per Lifeguard per hour.
  - Fees will increase in 2024.

### Water Slide:

- The water slide will only be available if a volunteer or Teacher is able to assist with the line up.
