- International foods and goods

Submission requirements:

- All submissions are subject to a selection process
- A brief description of products or service must be submitted with application form
- Late submissions will not be accepted
- Limited number of spaces available
- **All vendors MUST comply with Municipal Fire regulations and when cooking food on site and have the appropriate fire extinguisher**
- **Food vendors must have a Temporary Food Permit and/or copies of an approved Farmers Market Application from Interior Health**

Location & space allocation:

- Boitanio Park • Lot sizes: 10' x 10' • Electricity is not available
- 2019 festivities will be located around the Gwen Ringwood stage
- Mobile vendors will be placed in park Cul-de-sac on Borland Street OR by picnic shelter
- The location of vendors will be determined by the Cariboo Memorial Recreation Complex

Set up & take down:

- Vendors are required to do their own set up and take down
- Vendors supply their own tent, tables, chairs and power-silent generators
- Designated vendor parking is available in the park
- Vehicle access into park on paved sidewalks only - 7:00 - 10:30am
- Set-up must be completed by 11:00 am
- Late arrivals will not be accommodated
- Take-down: no earlier than 1:30pm, unless all goods are sold
- Signage must be confined to inside your booth
- This is an outdoor event, please come prepared for weather
- Booths must have a clean, attractive and professional appearance

Space and fees:

- CMRC will provide 1 Day Exhibition Business License for all vendors
- \$10.00 Non-refundable booking fee
